## Prospective Students and Families Frequently Asked Questions

Are you thinking about enrolling your child at MHS? Here are some FAQs to help as you navigate the process.

- 1. Do I have to pay tuition to send my child to MHS?
  - a. If you live within the city limits of Marietta, MHS is your zoned school and there is no charge. If you live outside of the city limits, MCS does allow students to apply as tuition students.
- 2. What is the process for applying as an out-of-district student and what is the timeline for application?

- 5. Is there a separate application process for students to be accepted into the IB programs at MHS?
  - a. No. Because we have an "IB for All" philosophy, there is no application process to enter any of our IB programs or to take individual IB classes. Students and families have the opportunity to examine the program requirements for the IB Diploma or Career-related Programme, talk with their school counselor, and meet with the IB DP/CP Coordinator in order to make the decision that is right for them. Additionally, all of our 9th and 10th graders are part of our IB Middle Years Programme, regardless of the course and regardless of their level of academic study.
